

### **COMPANY STRENGTHS**

The issuing of the amended Codes of Good Practice (the codes) under section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Economic Empowerment Act 2003, which took effect the on the 1st of May 2015, has had far reaching implications for big business in South Africa. In particular the focus on Enterprise and Supplier Development (ESD) component which has now become the biggest (40 points excluding bonus points) and most impactful contributor to the overall scorecard has been significant. In response to the changes to BBBEE codes, Africaneur IQ (Pty) Ltd developed an Enterprise Supplier Development Initiative, in order to transform its procurement spends on shrink wraps and other plastic products.
